CANCELED: All Lanes of I-635 Closed at Skillman Street to Perform Bridge Work Dec. 4

DALLAS – The full closures of eastbound and westbound I-635 mainlanes at Skillman Street, originally scheduled for Saturday evening, Dec. 4 lasting through Sunday morning, Dec. 5, has been canceled.

Other associated closures, including all lanes of Skillman Street overpass bridge has also been canceled in addition to the mainlane closures. Recent changes to the schedule are reflected below:

Saturday, Dec. 4 (CANCELED)

- **CANCELED:** All lanes of eastbound I-635 at Skillman Street.
DETOUR: Eastbound mainlane traffic will be detoured to take the exit to Skillman Street (Exit 16). Drivers will remain on the frontage road and will access eastbound I-635 using the entrance ramp after the Skillman Street intersection.
- **CANCELED:** All lanes of westbound I-635 at Skillman Street.
DETOUR: Westbound mainlane traffic will be detoured to take the exit to Skillman Street (Exit 16). Drivers will remain on the frontage road and will access westbound I-635 using the entrance ramp after the Skillman Street intersection.
- **CANCELED:** All lanes of northbound Skillman Street at I-635.
DETOUR: Northbound Skillman Street traffic will turn right on Royal Lane and left on Plano Road to access Forest Lane, which turns into Skillman Street.
- **CANCELED:** All lanes of southbound Skillman Street at I-635.
DETOUR: Southbound Skillman Street traffic will continue west along Forest Lane, turn left on Abrams Road and left on Royal Lane to access Skillman Street.

- **CANCELED:** All lanes of the westbound I-635 frontage road between Royal Lane/Miller Road and Skillman Street.
DETOUR: Drivers will enter onto westbound I-635 and will take the exit to Skillman Street.

About the 635 East Project

The 635 East Project is a \$1.7 billion design-build operation owned and managed by the Texas Department of Transportation. The goal of the 11-mile project is to improve mobility, operations and safety on Interstate 635 in Dallas County. Construction includes the addition of a mainlane in each direction, building continuous frontage roads along the corridor and reconstruction of the interchange at I-635 and I-30. Construction began in early 2020 with an anticipated completion date of late 2024. The 635 East Project is part of the Texas Clear Lanes initiative (www.texasclearlanes.com) by TxDOT to address growing traffic congestion in the state.
